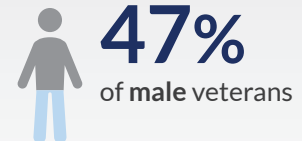
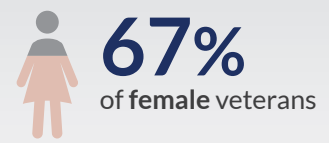

THOSE LIKELY TO LEAVE SERVICE IN NEXT TWO YEARS



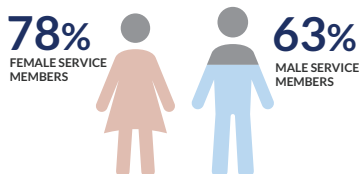
Top 3 Reasons Dual Military Service Members Plan to Exit Service*

- MILITARY LIFESTYLE DIDN'T ALLOW ME SUFFICIENT TIME WITH FAMILY
- CONCERNS ABOUT IMPACT OF MILITARY SERVICE ON FAMILY
- TOO MANY DEPLOYMENTS/OPTEMPO TOO HIGH
- LOST FAITH OR TRUST IN MILITARY OR POLITICAL LEADERSHIP

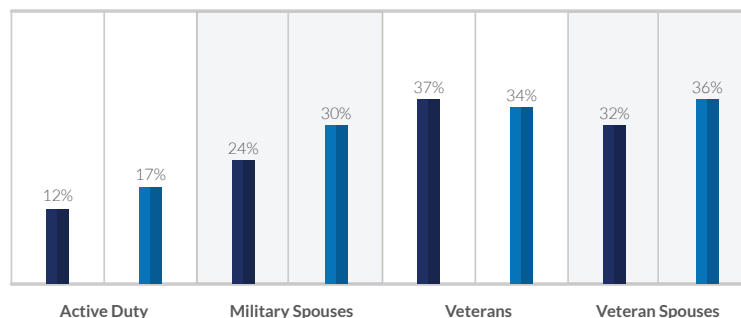
